Date	Offense	Details
	CIT	The Department responded to four calls for someone experiencing a mental health crisis.
	Driving While Intoxicated	Five people were arrested for Driving While Intoxicated.
	Leaving the Scene of an Accident	Two crashes occurred where one of the drivers left the scene; one was cleared.
	Domestic	One person was arrested for domestic assault this period.
	Failed to Yield	Four vehicles failed to yield stop when officers attempted to stop them.
1/16/2023	Burglary	Employee at 12400 Olive suite 402 reported business was burglarized and \$2800 was missing from the petty cash box. No forced entry.
1/16/2023	Burglary	800 Blk. Fernview Drive. Resident reported pry marks on a door and property damaged inside the home. The home had been vacant.
1/16/2023	Sexual Assault	Responded to the PD station for a female who reported being sexually assaulted on New Year's Eve. Detectives have been assigned the case and are investigating.

Date	Offense	Details
1/16/2023	Disturbance	Responded to the 12000 blk of Royal Valley Drive for a disturbance involving the resident's family and caregivers. Subjects provided information on obtaining civil court orders.
1/16/2023	Stolen Vehicle	Vehicle stolen from the 11500 blk. of Craig Court overnight. Resident reported that he had met a subject online at his apartment and, after the subject left, he realized that his car and car keys were missing. Vehicle later located by Officers in the Castle Point area of Moline Acres.

Date	Offense	Details
1/18/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Officers responded to 10271 Old Olive St. Rd. Owner reported that his vehicle window was broken out and his wallet was missing from inside the car, which contained \$300 cash. Suspect vehicle was a grey SUV, possibly an Audi.
1/18/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Victim reported that a grey Audi had pulled up to her vehicle while she was at the gas pump at 767 N. New Ballas. When she got back into her car (was left unlocked) her purse was missing with \$40 cash inside. Purse later located in a traffic lane on Olive Blvd, minus the cash.
1/18/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Owner reported that when he exited the theater at 10465 Olive after a movie, he found that the rear window to his truck was broken out, but nothing was missing from inside.

Analysis identified a suspect with a criminal record. Subject was booked and charges forwarded to the Prosecuting Attorney's office for consideration.
1/18/2023	Stolen Auto	Responded to 11464 Olive for a report of a stolen auto. Victim reported that her red SUV was stolen from the parking lot. Victim left the vehicle unlocked, with keys inside, while she was inside the business. Vehicle was used in additional crimes in Maryland Heights on 1/20, where the occupants were armed. The vehicle was recovered on 1/21 in Ferguson, parked and unoccupied.

1/20/2023	Arrest	Male subject was identified as the suspect of stealing a truck on 11/14/2022 from 969 N. Mason Road. Subject was already in custody of Missouri Dept. of Corrections. He was interviewed, arrested and released pending application of warrants. He remains in custody at the state prison.
1/20/2023	Arrest	Subject was arrested for an outstanding Creve Coeur warrant while in custody at Hazelwood PD. He later posted bond and was released.
1/21/2023	Disturbance	1000 blk. Rue De La Banque Drive. Officers met with a juvenile and the father relative to a disturbance. After an on-scene investigation, the case was referred to the Children's Division for further follow up.
1/21/2023	Assault	10457 Olive Blvd. Two female subjects were physically fighting in the parking lot outside of the movie theater. One subject had active warrants for her arrest from several jurisdictions and was taken into custody for those warrants. Both subjects were issued court summonses for peace disturbance.
