2/1/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Employee at 12395 Olive reported that her vehicle was entered. Some paperwork and a spare vehicle key were taken. Vehicle was left unlocked; no forced entry.

Date	Offense	Details
2/1/2023	Arrest	A man was arrested after a traffic stop for driving while suspended and traffic violations. Subject also had multiple arrest warrants outstanding from Maryland Heights and Florissant PD. Narcotics were discovered during the arrest, for which the subject was also charged.
2/2/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Victim reported that medication and lottery tickets were stolen from her vehicle while it was valet parked at 615 S. New Ballas Road. Officer is following up.
2/2/2023	Scam/Theft	Resident reported that a female subject called her at home posing as her granddaughter saying she needed bail money and was in jail in California. The caller convinced the victim to place \$7,600 in cash in an envelope on her porch. Shortly after, a vehicle pulled up and took the cash. The victim's granddaughter was later verified as never being arrested. Detectives are following up.
2/2/2023	Misc. Incident	Caller, a for-hire driver, advised a subject he was transporting to the airport had just ran from his vehicle while stopped on Olive Blvd. Officers investigated and determined that the subject was AWOL from the military. Military Police are following up.
2/2/2023	Arrest	A man was arrested for traffic offenses after a traffic stop. Subject was issued citations and released.
2/3/2023	Arrest	A subject wanted for a robbery that occurred in 10/2021 was determined to be in custody at Missouri Dept of Corrections in Pacific, MO. Subject was interviewed by Detectives and booked at the prison. Charges will be applied for at the Prosecuting Attorney's office.
2/3/2023	Arrest	1 College Park Lane. Public Safety Officers advised that they had located a backpack containing a firearm, cash and narcotics, hidden in some foliage on campus. A subject later reported the backpack missing, was interviewed by Officers and determined to be the owner of all the items. He was arrested for unlawful use of a weapon and released pending warrant application.

2/3/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Resident of 12300 Blk of Cross Creek Cove advised that her Air Pods had been stolen from her unlocked vehicle. Officer tracked the item to a residence in Wentzville. Wentzville PD contacted that resident and recovered them. Officer is following up further.
