	Domestic	No subjects were arrested for domestic assault this period.
	Failed to Yield	8 vehicles failed to yield stop when officers attempted to stop them.
2/16/2023	Theft	Victim advised that a utility trailer had been stolen from the worksite/parking lot at 701 S. New Ballas overnight. Victim said the trailer contained construction equipment and tools.
2/16/2023	Theft	Patient at 615 S. New Ballas advised that a bag containing personal property had been stolen after she left it unattended in the ICU waiting room.
2/17/2023	Arrest	Officer conducted a vehicle stop for a traffic violation. Driver was arrested for suspended driver's license and multiple arrest warrants from Manchester and Town and Country PD.

2/17/2023	Assist Another Agency	Officers assisted Ladue PD in a search to locate several burglary suspects who had fled to the area of Carter's Manor Drive, in Ladue. Officer located one subject hiding in the woods, took that person into custody and turned him over to Ladue PD.
2/17/2023	Assault/Larceny	Employee at 11560 Olive Blvd. advised that a customer inside the store was causing a disturbance. When the employee asked the person to leave, the male subject spat on the employee, destroyed merchandise, and walked out after stealing some items. The subject was located walking down Olive Blvd. and arrested by Officers.
2/17/2023	Theft from Vehicles	<p>Officer on patrol observed a suspicious vehicle (a white Lexus) driving slowly through business parking lots in the 10400 blk. of Olive Blvd. When the driver spotted the patrol car, it fled eastbound on Olive at a high rate of speed. The Officer did not pursue. Shortly thereafter, the Officer discovered several vehicles had been broken into in the area:</p> <p>Two trucks at 10465 Olive Blvd. had rear windows broken out, however owners reported nothing missing.</p> <p>A truck parked at 10401 Olive Blvd. had its window broken out. Owner reported a coach brand bag, wallet and pistol missing from inside the truck.</p>
2/17/2023	Theft from Vehicles	Front desk clerk at 11980 Olive Blvd. advised that two customers vehicles had been broken into. One vehicle, a Ford truck had two rear windows broken out, but nothing missing. The other vehicle, a Chrysler, had a window broken out and personal items missing.
2/18/2023	Property Damage	Resident of 9900 Blk of Warshire advised that the passenger side windows of his SUV were broken out overnight. No property was left in the car or taken.

2/18/2023	Misc.	An Officer observed the white Lexus SUV that had been stolen during a carjacking on 1/28 in Hazelwood driving on Cross Creek Drive, occupied by several male subjects. The vehicle fled before Officers could get in position to attempt to stop the vehicle.

2/19/2023	Burglary	Officers responded to 10900 blk. of Chase Park Lane for a report of a burglary just discovered. Resident advised that someone had forced entry in through a broken rear window and stolen a video gaming system and other personal property while she was gone.
2/20/2023	Stolen Vehicle	Officers responded to the police station where they contacted the victim who advised that his minivan had been stolen from the shoulder of I-270 overnight. The subject advised that he had left the keys in the van in order for a tow service to come pick it up, but when they arrived it was already gone.
2/20/2023	Theft from Vehicles	Employee at 11980 Olive advised that a dark colored sedan was on the parking lot and subjects were breaking into parked cars. Officers responded and upon arrival the suspect vehicle fled onto NB I-270. The vehicle is believed to be a black BMW or a black Chrysler.

2/22/2023	Theft	Owner reported that the catalytic converter had been stolen off of his vehicle while it was parked at 615 S. New Ballas Road between 10:30am – 7:30pm. Detectives are following up.
2/22/2023	Arrest	Officer stopped a vehicle for displaying a license plate from a different vehicle. Driver had a suspended license and numerous outstanding warrants for her arrest for traffic offenses and a felony charge from Florissant. Subject was arrested and later turned over to Florissant PD.
2/22/2023	Attempted Theft	Employee advised that a black vehicle pulled onto the parking lot at 11077 Olive and attempted to enter a vehicle parked on the lot. As Officers arrived, the vehicle fled the scene. The vehicle was located minutes later on Olive Blvd, but fled eastbound on Olive once Officers approached.

Date	Offense	Details
2/25/2023	Arrest	Officer on patrol recognized a subject soliciting for money at Olive and 270 that had given a false name during a prior contact. Officer stopped subject in order to issue a court summons for the prior violation, when a warrant was discovered for the subject's arrest from Stone County, Mo. When the subject was taken into custody for this warrant, narcotics were found on his person. Subject was released to St. Louis County Jail for the Stone County warrant and a warrant will be applied for the drug violation.
2/25/2023	Theft from Vehicles	10465 Olive Blvd. Three vehicles were broken into (windows broken) while parked at the theater. Stolen items included a purse, and a wallet. A black VW Passat with no license plates was seen in the area during the time of the thefts.
2/25/2023	Failure to Yield	Officer on patrol observed the black VW Passat from the incident above at the Petromart – Olive at N. New Ballas. The vehicle fled when the patrol vehicle approached. The Officer tried to stop the car, but it fled eastbound on Olive Blvd, towards I-170.
2/26/2023	Attempted Burglary	Resident of 1100 blk. of Town and Four Drive advised that his girlfriend had called him just as he was arriving at home and sounded panicked. The resident immediately entered his home to check on his girlfriend, whereupon he saw a male subject (a stranger) wearing dark clothing standing inside the kitchen. The victim then fired 3-4 shots at the intruder who fled out the rear sliding glass door. Apparently, the subject was not struck by any of the gunfire. Detectives are following up.
2/26/2023	Recovered Stolen Vehicle/Weapons & Narcotics Arrest	Officer on patrol observed a rental truck parked on the gas station parking lot at 767 N. New Ballas which had been recently reported stolen from St. Louis City. When the Officer made contact with two male occupants, the passenger was found to be in possession of a firearm (prior felon) and narcotics. The passenger was arrested for these charges. St. Louis City PD refused to take custody of the driver for operating the stolen vehicle; he was identified and released at the scene. The vehicle was towed to await the owner.
2/27/2023	Arrest	Following a traffic stop, a male driver was taken into custody for outstanding charges from Florissant and Bellefontaine Neighbors PD. He was later released to Florissant PD.

2/27/2023	Arrest	A female driver was taken into custody for outstanding warrants from St. Charles County PD during a traffic stop. She was later released after posting bond for the charges.
2/28/2023	Vehicle Crash/Arrest	Officers responded to 11221 Olive Blvd. for a vehicle crash. While handling the incident, it was discovered that one of the drivers had outstanding warrants for his arrest. That subject was arrested for driving without a valid license and warrants from St. Louis County and St. Louis City. He was later released to St. Louis County PD.
