	CIT	The Department responded to 3 calls for someone experiencing a mental health crisis.
	Driving While Intoxicated	4 people were arrested for Driving While Intoxicated.
	Leaving the Scene of an Accident	No crashes occurred where one of the drivers left the scene.
	Domestic	No subjects were arrested for domestic assault this period.
	Failed to Yield	7 vehicles failed to yield stop when officers attempted to stop them.
3/2/2023	Arrest	Officer conducted a vehicle stop for a traffic violation. Driver was arrested for multiple arrest warrants from Florissant, St. Louis City, Maryland Heights and Creve Coeur PD.
3/2/2023	Fraud	11655 Olive Blvd: employee of a business in Ballwin reported that a former employee made several unauthorized withdrawals from the company's bank account in Creve Coeur.
3/3/2023	Drone Deployment	Officer assisted Ladue PD with a call of a burglary in progress in their venue. Two juveniles were located and taken into custody by LPD.
3/3/2023	Sexual Assault	Victim reported that she was sexually assaulted at an apartment in Creve Coeur in January. The victim did not know the address, but is working with Detectives to identify the location and suspect (an acquaintance).

Date	Offense	Details
3/3/2023	Assist Another Agency/Drone Deployment	Officers assisted Ladue PD in a search to locate several burglary suspects who had fled to the area of Carter's Manor Drive, in Ladue. CCPD Officer on foot located one subject hiding in the woods, took that person into custody and turned him over to Ladue PD.
3/4/2023	Drone Deployment	Officer assisted Town and Country PD with a call of a suspicious persons running through backyards in their venue. Officer deployed drone, but no one was located.
3/4/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped for a traffic violation and arrested for outstanding warrants from Chesterfield PD.
3/5/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Resident of 12100 Blk of Royal Valley Drive advised that a handgun was taken from his unlocked vehicle.
3/5/2023	Arrest	Frontenac PD dropped a subject off at the CCPD station that had an active Creve Coeur warrant. The subject was booked and posted her bond. Subject also had warrants from Bridgeton and Maryland Heights.
3/6/2023	Business Burglary	Caller reported that someone had entered the business after hours at 1066 Executive Parkway. The interior of the business was ransacked and the cashbox was forced open. No signs of forced entry – door may have been left unlocked.
3/7/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Subject reported that his unlocked vehicle was entered while he was attending a service at 12136 Olive Blvd; a handgun was stolen.
3/7/2023	Theft	Victim reported that several pieces of jewelry were missing while she had a medical appointment at 615 S. New Ballas. She had removed the items and forgot to put them back on afterwards. Staff checked the area, but someone had taken the jewelry.

Date	Offense	Details
3/7/2023	Fraud	Resident came to the station and reported that someone had opened a small business loan with the US Small Business Administration fraudulently in his name. Detectives are following up.
3/7/2023	Fraud	Resident reported that someone had gained access to his crypto currency account and transferred all the funds out. Detectives are following up.
3/8/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped for a traffic violation and arrested for outstanding warrants from St. Louis County PD and O'Fallon PD.
3/8/2023	Unlawful Use of a Weapon	Caller reported hearing 3 to 4 shots in the area of Country Manor Drive. Officers responded and checked a resident's video doorbell (with their consent) and discovered that the subject who fired the shots was driving a grey Dodge passenger car. A LPR (license plate reading) camera nearby had recorded the license plate of the vehicle and Officers responded to that address, which was in an apartment complex a short distance away. The resident at that apartment admitted to firing shots in the air from his vehicle's open sunroof – the subject explained that he had done this to impress a friend that was riding with him. Subject was arrested for unlawful use of a weapon.
3/9/2023	Fraud	Resident of 1000 blk N. Warson Road reported that someone had sent him a message via text threatening him and his family for "harassment" and demanded payment. The victim sent the subject funds through an internet cash app. Days later, the subject sent another demand for more money. The victim then decided to report the fraud. Officers checked and the phone number the perpetrator provided is a shell/false number. Detectives are following up.
3/9/2023	Trespassing	Officers responded to 11980 Olive for a report of a subject in the lobby creating a disturbance. Upon arrival, a male subject was contacted who had a dispute with management. Hotel management told the subject to leave in the Officer's presence, but the subject refused and instead tried to push past the Officers

		and access the elevator. The subject was arrested and booked at the station for trespassing.
3/9/2023	Business Burglary	Caller reported that someone had entered the business after hours at 655 Craig Road. The front desk of the business was ransacked, but no property was missing - the subject was gone on Officers' arrival. No signs of forced entry – door may have been left unlocked.
3/9/2023	Drone Deployment	Officer assisted Town and Country PD with a residential burglary call in their venue. Officers deployed drone, but no one was located.
3/10/2023	Arrest	Officer conducted a vehicle stop for a traffic violation. Driver was arrested for driving while suspended and traffic offenses.
3/10/2023	Unlawful Use of a Weapon	Caller reported that a subject was firing shots at a vehicle on the parking lot at 11560 Olive Blvd. Officers located a subject walking in an office complex nearby. The subject was in possession of a handgun and confirmed that he was involved in the incident. The subject was an employee at the business and claimed he had been assaulted by a male that came in the business. The subjects are previous acquaintances. The employee followed the subject into the parking lot after he was assaulted and fired shots at the subject as he left in a vehicle. The second subject has not been located yet, but is not believed to have been injured. The employee was arrested and charged with unlawful use of a weapon and armed criminal action. Detectives are following up.
