	CIT	The Department responded to 3 calls for someone experiencing a mental health crisis.
	Driving While Intoxicated	6 people were arrested for Driving While Intoxicated.
	Leaving the Scene of an Accident	4 crashes occurred where one of the drivers left the scene.
	Domestic	No subjects were arrested for domestic assault this period.
	Failed to Yield	2 vehicles failed to yield stop when officers attempted to stop them.
3/16/2023	Property Damage	Victim called to report that his company vehicle had been damaged sometime between 2/22-3/16 while parked in the parking garage at 615 S. New Ballas. The door lock had been damaged as well as the ignition switch.
3/16/2023	Dog Bite	Delivery driver reported that he delivered a pizza to an apartment in the 700 blk. of Cross Creek Drive. When the occupant of the apartment opened the door, the dog ran out and bit the delivery driver. St. Louis County Animal Control was advised and is following up.
3/17/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Victim who resides in the 1000 blk. of Rue La Ville Walk advised that someone had some personal items were missing from inside of his vehicle which was left unlocked overnight.
3/17/2023	Sick Case	Officer responded to the parking lot at 11553 Olive Blvd. for a call of a person down. Upon arrival the subject was given 3 doses of Narcan and revived. Subject was transported to the hospital, now alert and breathing.

Date	Offense	Details
3/17/2023	Trespassing	Security at the hospital at 615 S. New Ballas Road advised that a subject who had been released from the ER refused to leave and was causing a disturbance. Officers made contact and requested that the subject leave. After several requests were made and the subject refused to leave, she was arrested and processed.
3/17/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped for a traffic violation (driving while license suspended) and arrested for outstanding warrants from Jefferson County and St. Louis County PD.
3/18/2023	Arrest	A female subject was stopped for a traffic violation and arrested for driving while suspended and no registration.
3/20/2023	Arrest	A female subject was stopped for a traffic violation (expired temp tags) and arrested for outstanding warrants from Florissant and Calverton Park PD.
3/21/2023	Fraud	Officer responded to 12300 Olive Blvd for a fraud report. An employee reported that a new account had been opened on 3/17 and \$2.5m deposited via wire transfer. Today a female subject came in and tried to cash a \$1.1m check at the bank. The bank employee would only provide \$5,000, placing the rest on hold. After the subject left, the employee checked with the bank that provided the initial wire transfer (out of state) and discovered the initial wire transfer was fraudulent. Officer is following up with federal authorities for further investigation.
3/21/2023	Arrest	A female subject was stopped for a traffic violation and arrested for driving with a revoked driver's license and outstanding warrants from St. Peter's PD.
3/22/2023	Theft from a Vehicle	Employee at 10405 Old Olive St. Rd. reported that an air conditioner had been stolen from the company work van sometime between 3/17 and 3/21.
3/22/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped for a traffic violation and arrested for driving with a suspended driver's license and outstanding warrants from Chesterfield, and Town and Country PD.

3/23/2023	Harassment	Employee at 11647 Olive called to report harassment from a customer. Officer is following up.
3/23/2023	Recovered Stolen Property	Officers responded to calls of a car fire at 789 Cross Creek Drive. Witnesses reported that a male subject had parked the car as it was smoking and then fled, stating that he had outstanding warrants. Officers determined that the vehicle was displaying stolen plates from St. Louis County PD. Plates were recovered at the vehicle was towed.
3/23/2023	Arrest	A female subject was stopped on I-270 for a traffic violation (expired temp tags) and was arrested for outstanding warrants from Chesterfield and Manchester PD.
3/24/2023	Arrest	Officer responded to St. Louis County PD and picked up a subject wanted for a Creve Coeur warrant for failure to appear – driving while revoked.
3/24/2023	Remembrance	March 23rd marks 55 years since the loss of Creve Coeur Police Officer Larry Howard, who was lost in the line of duty on Sunday, March 24th, 1968. PO Howard was killed at the intersection of Ladue and Lindbergh while on an emergency run with a mother in labor in the backseat of his patrol car. A motorist disobeyed the electric signal for southbound Lindbergh, running the red light and broadsided PO Howard's patrol vehicle. PO Howard was 24 years old and had been with CCPD for 2 years. At that time, he had two children, one three years old and one just under a year old. Since then, the police department has kept in touch with the family and each year members of the Howard family join the Creve Coeur table at the Officer's Prayer Breakfast held in May.
3/24/2023	Theft	Employee at 12428 Olive reported that a homeless man had come into the store saying he was hungry and asking for food. While the employee went into the back to obtain a meal to donate, the man stole \$180 from the front counter, then took the food and fled.
3/24/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped while turning into the parking lot at 11464 Olive for a traffic violation (illegal/hazardous turn). A computer check revealed the subject was driving while revoked and had several outstanding warrants from Olivette, St. Peters, and O'Fallon PD. The man was arrested for these warrants.

Date	Offense	Details
3/24/2023	Arrest	767 N. New Ballas: Employee reported that a subject was inside the business causing a disturbance. The manager told the subject to leave and not to come back. Officers also asked the subject to leave and offered options on providing him a ride home. The subject refused to leave and continued to cause a disturbance. He was arrested for trespassing and processed at the station.
3/25/2023	Theft	Store manager at 767 N. New Ballas reported that an ex-employee entered the business and accessed the safe. The subject stolen ~\$300 in cash and left. Officer is following up.
3/25/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped on I-270 for a traffic violation (speeding) and was arrested for outstanding warrants from Maplewood PD.
3/25/2023	Arrest	Officer conducted a vehicle stop for a traffic violation on Cross Creek Drive. Female driver was arrested for an outstanding warrant from St. Charles City PD.
3/25/2023	Arrest	Officers contacted a subject in the ER at 12634 Olive Blvd. who matched the description of the subject in the earlier entry who had stolen \$180 after asking for a charity meal at a local restaurant. The subject was identified as the same person and taken into custody. While being searched, two glass narcotic pipes and a stolen credit card from O'Fallon PD was discovered. Subject was processed at the station on these charges.
3/26/2023	Theft	Victim reported that he had parked his Ferrari convertible at 10941 Olive with his briefcase inside the open car. When he returned to the car from shopping inside Walgreens, the briefcase was missing. Officers are investigating.
3/26/2023	Property Damage	Officer on routine patrol observed a suspicious vehicle driving around the parking lot at 11980 Olive Blvd. Upon approaching the vehicle, it fled onto NB I-270. Officer checked the parking lot and discovered a pick-up truck with a broken-out window. The owner responded and advised that nothing appeared to be missing.
3/27/2023	Arrest	While handling a crash investigation on I-270, Officer determined that one of the drivers had outstanding warrants for her arrest from Florissant and St. Louis County PD.

3/27/2023	Fraud	Employee at 12500 Olive Blvd. advised that the bank had accepted a fraudulent check and the subject had cashed part of it. Detectives are following up.
3/27/2023	Arrest	Officer conducted a vehicle stop for a traffic violation on I-270. Female driver was arrested for driving while suspended and later released on a court summons.
3/28/2023	Arrest	Subject was picked up from St. Charles County jail for an outstanding Creve Coeur municipal warrant.
3/28/2023	Arrest	Following a traffic stop in the 11500 blk. of Olive, a male driver was taken into custody for driving while revoked and seven outstanding warrants from multiple agencies. Subject was later turned over to Florissant PD.

3/31/2023	Fraud	Victim reported that she had left her wallet in a ride-share and a credit card was now being used fraudulently. Officer is following up.
