Date	Offense	Details
	CIT	The Department responded to 7 calls for someone experiencing a mental health crisis.
	Driving While Intoxicated	3 people were arrested for Driving While Intoxicated.
	Leaving the Scene of an Accident	5 crashes occurred where one of the drivers left the scene.
	Domestic	2 subjects were arrested for domestic assault this period.
	Failed to Yield	6 vehicles failed to yield stop when officers attempted to stop them.
4/1/2023	Arrest	Officers responded to Olive Blvd. at Orchard Lakes for a vehicle stopped in the grass, while running. The female driver was sleeping in the car and found to be in possession of suspected narcotics.
4/1/2023	Attempt Suicide	Officers arrived at the Olive and I-270 overpass after getting a call of an intoxicated person walking on the overpass. Upon arrival they discovered that the person was standing on a concrete planter that overlooked the interstate, only one step away from plunging to her death. The Officers spoke with the person and, after developing a relationship, they were able to talk her off the edge of the overpass and conveyed her to the hospital for mental health treatment.
4/1/2023	Attempt Suicide	Minutes after clearing the previous call, Officers received a call of a suicidal person inside a vehicle at the West Oak shopping plaza. Upon arrival, the Officers contacted the driver who had reportedly overdosed on medications, but was currently conscious. As Officers spoke to the subject, the subject suddenly put his car in gear and drove backwards striking a patrol car and hitting an Officer. The subject fled onto Olive and then onto NB I-270 where he was stopped by another CCPD Officer. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the hospital for evaluation and treatment. The Officer was also taken to the hospital for treatment.

4/1/2023	Disturbance	Officers responded to the 900 blk. of Bellerive Manor Drive for a call of a juvenile party. Upon arrival Officers contacted a juvenile leaving the area that confirmed that there was a party inside the home, the party consisted of juveniles and they were drinking alcoholic beverages. Officers contacted the female adult homeowner who said that she would not allow Officers to enter. Since the homeowner was knowing allowing the unruly conduct, she was issued a court summons.
4/2/2023	Burglary	Homeowner reported that their residence had been burglarized in the 10800 block of Rondelay Drive. Person(s) unknown had broken out a window on the side of the home to gain access and awoken the residents, who called 911. Nothing reported as missing.
4/3/2023	Arrest	Officer responded to St. Louis County PD and picked up a male subject already in custody for an active Creve Coeur warrant for failure to appear.
4/4/2023	Theft	Victim reported that two construction trailers were broken into while parked overnight on the parking lot at 12766 Olive Blvd. Several pieces of construction equipment are missing.
4/5/2023	Missing Person	Employee at 1220 N. Lindbergh advised that an 18-year-old male client was missing after not returning to the facility. The subject is a ward of the state and was requesting services at the business. Officer is following up.
4/6/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped for a traffic violation on SB I-270 and arrested for outstanding warrants from Bridgeton, Cottleville and St. Peter's PD.
4/6/2023	Fraud	After investigation, Detectives arrested a man in Jennings for fraudulently manufacturing checks and cashing them back in August 2022. The victim is a Creve Coeur resident who discovered the theft when checking her banking records.
4/6/2023	Fraud	Employees at 12275 Olive Blvd. called the police department when a male subject had tried to cash a check inside the bank. The account holder had previously reported that the check had been stolen from the US mail. Officers arrived and arrested the male while still inside the bank.

4/7/2023	Assault - Shooting	Multiple witnesses reported a male subject that had produced a handgun and shot at another male subject in front of 12536 Olive Blvd. The victim, who was hit in the arm and abdomen, ran across Olive to Heritage Plaza Dierbergs to get away from the shooter. The suspect fled in a blue vehicle, east on Olive. Investigation revealed that the two men are (were) friends and became involved in a dispute in front of the business. Detectives have identified a suspect and are following up.
4/8/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped on I-270 for a traffic violation and was arrested for driving while revoked.
4/8/2023	Arrest	A male subject was stopped on Olive Blvd. for a traffic violation (speeding) and was arrested for outstanding warrants from St. Louis County PD.
4/8/2023	Property Damage	Officer responded to the area of Sarah Lane for multiple vehicles that had been broken into overnight. The owners of three vehicles were contacted and advised that they were not missing any property.
4/10/2023	Property Damage	12300 blk. of Cross Creek Drive. Two owners each reported that their vehicles had been broken into overnight and the steering column damaged (both were Kias).
4/10/2023	Arrest	A female subject was contacted at 615 S. New Ballas after security called to say that she had outstanding warrants and needed to leave the property. The subject was arrested and conveyed to the station for warrants from Lincoln County SD.

4/13/2023	Theft	Victim reported that her Cash App card was stolen while she was getting coffee at 11464 Olive. The card was used (but declined) at a retail store in Overland by two females. Officer is following up.
4/15/2023	Stolen Vehicle	Female victim advised that she had parked her car at 11560 Olive and went inside the store. She had left her vehicle running with her boyfriend's cousin in the passenger seat. When she came out of the store, the vehicle was gone. She called the cousin and he confirmed that he had taken the car. Victim later took a bus to Ferguson and found the car.
